7 PRINCIPLES

- This short article presents a snippet of Dr. Byron Klaus's notes (in which I was a student).

1ST PRINCIPLE - HUMILITY

- Jesus humbled himself
- And allowed God to exalt Him.

2ND PRINCIPLE – FOLLOW THE FATHER

- Jesus followed His Father's will
- Rather than sought a position.

3RD PRINCIPLE – BE A SERVANT

- Jesus defined greatness as being a servant.
- Being first is becoming a slave.

4TH PRINCIPLE – RISK SERVING OTHERS

- Jesus risked himself to serve others
- Because He trusted that He was God's son.

5TH PRINCIPLE – PUT THE NEEDS OF OTHERS FIRST

- Jesus left His place at the head table.
- He served the needs of others.

6TH PRINCIPLE – SHARE RESPONSIBILITY

- Jesus shared Responsibility and Authority with those He called to lead.

7TH PRINCIPLE – BUILD A TEAM

- Jesus built a team to carry out a worldwide vision.

DEFINITION OF SERVANT LEADERSHIP

- A Servant Leader = *Serving the Mission* and
 - *Leads by Serving* those on mission with him

- “We who lead often overlook that the true place of Christlike leadership is out in the crowd rather than up at the head table.”

THE SERVANT LEADERSHIP MODEL OF JESUS



4 Key Concepts

- Mission
 - God's call on your life
 - Jesus's mission was to serve as the Messiah
- Vision
 - Your unique take on that mission
 - Jesus led his followers to see the Vision of His Kingdom
- Equip
 - How you train others to join you on mission to complete the Vision
 - Jesus led his disciples by telling them to "follow me" – and he trained them.
- Team
 - How you mobilize those you have equipped to carry out the mission beyond your departure
 - Jesus served his disciples during his time on earth and set an example for them to follow.
